Workshop description: The two workshops will be conducted in Owl's Head, Maine at David's summer house and studio. Each will be five intensive days of painting watercolors with David in the beautiful harbors and coastline near his studio. The week includes an evening lecture with desert, a visit to Miller's Lobster Pound and ends with a Maine coast luncheon hosted by David and his wife Kathy.

The workshops begin each morning with a lecture and demonstration that will include: drawing, design and color principles, and visual, technical and other practical methods of painting watercolors on location. Each day ends with critique and suggestions of the days painting.
